On February 15, 2012 you completed our Not In Custody package for a stalking complaint against Kevin Milcheck. As part of our review, we looked at your affidavit of facts, statements from Christine Swain, John Dent, Mike Lynch, Kevin Milcheck, numerous web sites with nude pictures, police report from Fort Lauderdale, Ms Seymour detailed letter, Golds Gym news article, police reports from Mount Dora, numerous meeting with you and your husband, Mr. Milcheck phone records and a letter from the Home Society stating they don't have a video that was subpoenaed..

According to the above documents, you came in contact with Mr. Milcheck in Golds Gym in Mount Dora and claim that after that meeting, you were harassed by Mr. Milcheck. You also claim that after you moved to South Florida, the harassment continued with phone calls, e- mails, and being followed. You indicate that you might have saw him a few weeks ago in a park. Mr Milcheck has dened these allegations and provided witnesses that indicate that all investigations at the gym did not appear to show any harassment.

In order to support the charge of stalking, a pattern of unreasonable harassment must have occurred. Their neededs to a be reasonable likelihood of conviction. In your case, no evidence exists at this time to support the charge of Stalking. An independent witness that supports this claim has not been provided to our office, as of this date. You provided a list of numbers that appeared on your phone, that were unaccounted for (You thought that the suspect was the caller), but according too the phone records of Mr. Milcheck; known of these suspicious numbers showed up on the phone bill.. No independent proof to show that he is following you appears.
